Adults are always responsible for the safety of the young children in their lives.

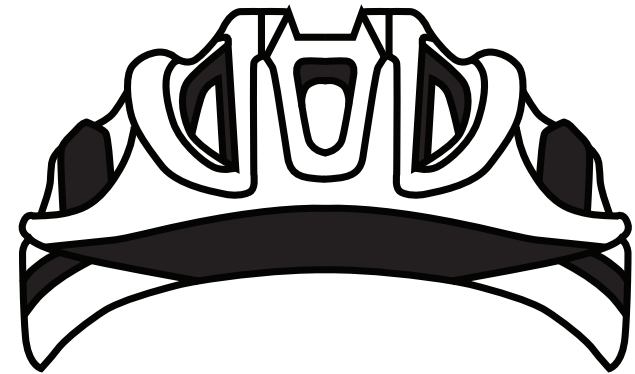
Keep children safe by ensuring:
